- Resolve any outstanding grades Friday, April 18, 2025, deadline to clear Fall 2024 incompletes.
- Schedule an appointment with your Advisor to verify total credit hour and area distribution requirements.
- Obtain final signature from Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, Dr. Frederick Ware.
- Complete the Association of Theological Schools (ATS) Graduation Student Questionnaire (GSQ) by sent via email.
- Return application complete with required signatures to Jazmin Bridges, Academic Records Coordinator, Office # 415, for additional processing.
